IN APRIL 2007 JOHN WAS DIAGNOSED WITH WALDENSTROM'S MACROGLOBULINEMIA WHICH AFFECTS THE PRODUCTION OF PLASMA CELLS CAUSING THE BODY TO MAKE TOO MANY OF THE WRONG KIND OF PLASMA CELLS. THIS MAKES THE BLOOD THICKER AND CAUSES A NUMBER OF SYMPTOMS LIKE LOW IRON IN THE BLOOD. TREATED WITH PHERESIS AND CHEMO THE RESUTS OF THERAPY ARE GOOD BUT NOT PERMANENT. JOHN WILL BE UNDERGOING A SERIES OF TREATMENTS OVER A PERIOD OF 18-24 WEEKS AND THEN ONCE EVERY 3 MONTHS FOR 2 YEARS. THEN WE WAIT AND WATCH TIL MORE TREATMENT IS NECESSARY
